New Business Items were discussed:

Chuck and Rick attended the District Emergency ARES meeting last week.

<u>Hospital Radios</u> – Wis Comm Radios are required in each hospital and the hospitals were given a radio. They use a VHF trunk system. Stan is researching the hospitals with the radios. \*The radios need to be tested each month\* Chuck will reach out to Mark Wilfur (New London Fire Chief) who is in charge of maintenance at the Waupaca Riverside Hospital and our contact person for getting into the radio room. Entrance to the hospital radio room will probably be with the Waupaca County ARES Badges that were given out this year to members who completed ICS 100 and 700 certifications. Check-in process through emergency room was discussed. More information will be finalized once Stan checks the hospitals and Chuck talks to Mark Wilfur.

<u>King Radio</u> – Carl Young asked about the radio at King Veterans Home. Chuck mentioned Leighton tested the radio recently and it works. It is located in the King VH Fire Department building in the Security building section. The radio is in the room to the right in the Security building.

Both the hospital and King radio may need to be updated with updates that Dave (WB9BGB) has.

**SIMCOM** – May 3<sup>rd</sup> – May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023, SIMCOM will be held in Brown County.

The schedule is as follows: **Day 1** - Training **Day 2** - Interagency Connecting **Day 3** - Experiment Day (1/2 day) <u>Exact Brown County location TBD</u>
